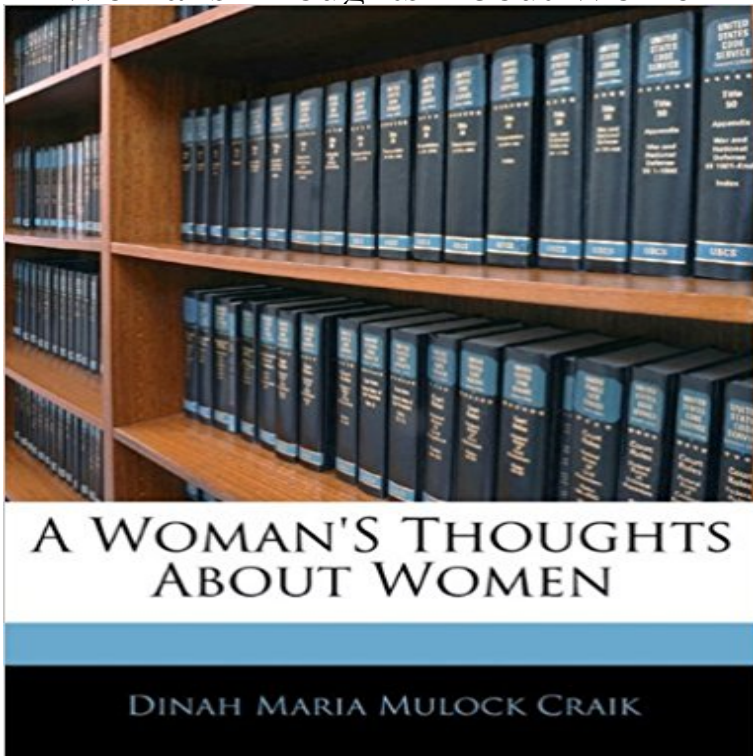


## A Womans Thoughts About Women
