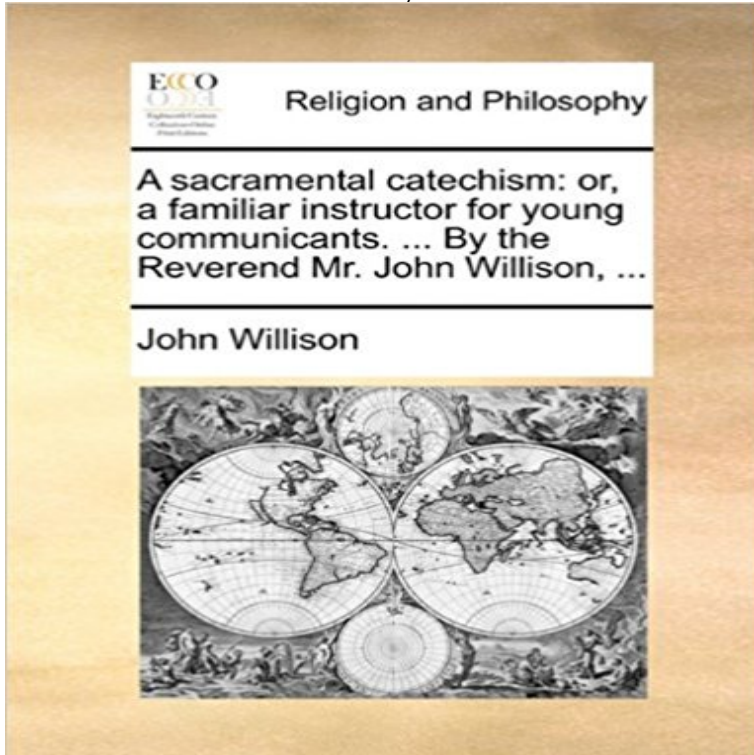


A sacramental catechism: or, a familiar instructor for young communicants. ... By the Reverend Mr. John Willison, ...
